Progress summary

Main construction works for the upgrade of Willoughby Public School have now been completed.

This project now allows the school to accommodate up to 1,200 students in these permanent facilities:

- 20 new permanent learning spaces
- a new special programs room
- new administration and staff facilities
- a new canteen and hall
- increased and improved outdoor play space, including a new multi sports court
- a covered outdoor learning area.

School holiday works

Work carried out between Monday 6 July and Saturday 18 July 2020 includes:

- final close out works across the school
- final relocations into new facilities
- starting demountable removal from the oval
- commencing playground installation on Medway Lane.

Work hours are 7:00am to 5:00pm Monday to Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or Public Holidays.

Some noisy works will take place over the school holiday period at the front entrance of the school.

Traffic control will be in place on Keary Street while trucks pick up the demountable units.

Works to remove demountables, restore the oval and complete the Medway Lane playground will continue following the Term 2 holidays.
