RESPECT + RESPONSIBILITY + SAFETY



It is great that many of the social restrictions re: COVID-19 are being eased..

However, there is still a long way to go and a lot we need to do to help keep ourselves and others as safe as possible;

Our School is taking our health advice from the NSW Government and NSW Department of Education

We are all expected to follow these directives for the
good of ourselves, each other and our broader
community.

We continue to have additional cleaners and cleaning of
the school throughout the day.

Even though most of us will know most of this already...

It is important that we are ***all*** on the same page and know exactly what is expected of us so we can *all* take a **collective responsibility** for how we keep our community **as safe as possible.**

We can wash and sanitise our hands frequently

- Washing our hands with soap and water for at least 30 seconds is recommended as the best way to reduce the spread of germs from our hands.
- At the beginning of every class, teachers will ask you to sanitise your hands with 'liquid sanitiser'. They may ask you again if you leave the room or touch other objects around the room.
- If they happen to forget - politely remind them :)

Some other things we can do;

Coughing/sneezing into our elbow

Avoid touching our face, mouth and eyes

Limiting the equipment we touch

Not sharing pens, drink bottles, food etc Students are not to use bubblers.

Only use one desk or computer - You will be asked to wipe these down before and after use.

Wipe down any equipment we might use eg. in Science Lab, Cooking Rooms or Tech rooms etc.

Social Distancing

We have been advised that social distancing does not need to apply between students while at school eg. in class or the playground.

Social distancing of at least 1.5m **DOES** apply between **STAFF** and **ADULTS** and **STUDENTS** and **STAFF**

This means that when interacting with the STAFF you will be expected to maintain at least 1.5m away.

eg. stay away from the 'teachers space / desk' in class.

To help remind us of social distancing;

Red crosses have been placed at key areas such as entrances to Offices, Staff Rooms and the Front Office etc.

Staff and students are required to wait at the cross to be seen.

NO STUDENTS are to ENTER STAFF ROOMS.

If we are not feeling well

Staff and students with any form of illness are required to stay home from school.

If you are feeling unwell throughout the day. Tell a staff member and we can make arrangements for you to go home.

Please remember...

We all have a part to play in how we manage and get through this together.

We all have a **responsibility** to ourselves, our family and our community.

By doing this we are **respecting** ourselves and each other and maintaining our **safety** as much as possible.
