

# Remembrance Day Education Grants Program Entry Information

### General

The Remembrance Day EGP is a charitable program sponsored by the Forestville RSL sub-Branch, the purpose of which is to provide financial assistance to eligible applicants who are entering Year 7 in the year following the closing of applications.

#### The Grant

The grant will be valued at \$2,000. It is expected that the grants will be spent on school uniforms and computer equipment to assist in the cost of transitioning from primary school to high school.

### **Eligibility Requirements**

An eligible applicant for the Remembrance Day EGP may be defined as:

- a. the child of a serving ADF member living and schooling within the Forestville RSL sub-Branch geographic area (contained within postcodes of 2084 (but excluding Cottage Point), 2085, 2086 2087 or 2100 (but excluding Brookvale, Manly Vale and Warringah Mall); **or**
- b. the child of the family of a Service member of the Forestville RSL sub-Branch (whether the Service member is living or deceased) living and schooling within the Forestville RSL sub-Branch geographic area; **or**
- c. the child of the family of a Service member of any RSL sub-Branch (whether the Service member is living or deceased) living and schooling within the Forestville RSL sub-Branch geographic area; and
- d. the child is entering Year 7 of High School the year after the application is made.

Family of a Service member of the Forestville RSL sub-Branch or any RSL sub-Branch includes the children; grand-children; or, the direct descendants of the Service member.

The onus is on the applicant to provide evidence of their eligibility for the grant.

### **Entry Requirements**

In addition to meeting the eligibility requirements applicants need to:

- a. submit by hand, post or email by 11 November a written 500-word biography on their ancestor, which includes a short outline of their military service, and
- b. prepare a three-minute talk to be delivered to the Grant organising sub-committee on 23 November.
- c. Thereafter, be prepared to deliver the talk to the sub-Branch General Meeting, held on the evening of 2 December at the Forestville RSL Club.

Requirements b. and c. above may be subject to modification because of Covid-19 restrictions.

### **Application Form**
