Stage 1 News – Year 1 and Year 2

A Focus on Poetry

For the next 2 weeks all of Year 1 and 2 will create different styles of poetry.

This week our poetry focus is creating a Spring Cinquain

WALT (We Are Learning To)	Investigate what poetry is and what forms poetry comes in
WILF (What I'm Looking For)	 Students who can identify that poetry can be written for different purposes Students who can identify that poetry can have many different structures Students who can follow a given poetic structure to create their own poem (cinquain)

We watched YouTube explanations of what poetry is. Then we discussed a certain poem structure called a cinquain. A cinquain is a 5-line poem with specific "rules" for the types of words to use. The rules are:

1st line = one-word title

2nd line = 2x adjectives

 3^{rd} line = 3x verbs

4th line = a 4-word phrase or short sentence with 4 words

5th line = one-word (can be a synonym for the title or a emotion word that you feel for the topic)




This is an example of a cinquain following the correct structure
