Our PBL focus at the moment is Respect and all students are encouraged to show respect for our school by consistently taking pride in themselves and our school by wearing the correct uniform, looking after their own and others' belongings and treating all people and things with care and respect.

## Geography

This Semester's lessons focus on the investigation of the significance of the natural environment of Australia. Students learn about what living things need to survive and how they interact and rely on specific natural environments for this survival. This includes thinking about what humans need to survive and how they source these things.

### Key Concepts, Skills and Understandings:

One specific lesson investigates what people need for survival. Students are asked to think about human needs and how they are sourced. Food is examined more closely, and the students are guided in their own research about the history of Australian foods.
