The Rotary Club of Bungendore is again conducting its primary schools' public speaking competition for schools in the Lake George region. It will again be divided into two sections, the first being for students in years 3 - 5 and the second for year 6 students.

Students who elect to participate will present their speech in Week 10, on Monday 28th March. Three finalists from years 3-5 and three finalists from year 6 will be selected to represent Sutton Public School at the Rotary Competition.

This year's competition will be held on Tuesday, 5 April at the Bungendore War Memorial Hall, 51 Molonglo St Bungendore. Registration of participating speakers will commence at 5.30pm with competition to commence promptly at 6.00pm.

The necessary information to enter the competition is included below.

The topics chosen for this year's competition are: -

<u>Years 3 - 5</u> - All presentations in this section shall be of a <u>maximum</u> of three (3) minutes duration.

- 1. What was the most fun that you had during lockdown last year and why?
- 2. What animal would you be if you could be an animal for a day and why?
- 3. Why should everyone eat more vegetables?
- 4. A topic of your choice about something you could do to help the environment.

Year 6 - All presentations in this section shall be of four (4) minutes duration.

- 1. What was the best part of lockdown for you?
- 2. What is the best invention from the last 10 years and why?
- 3. Is homework important?
- 4. A topic of your own choice about something the community could do to help the environment.
