

Expression of Interest - Stage 3 Camp 2022 – Bathurst Excursion

Monday 17 October – Wednesday 19 October, 2022

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are excited to share with you that students in Stage 3 (Years 5 & 6) are invited to attend a 3 day (2 night) camp to Bathurst in Term 4 from Monday 17 October to Wednesday 19 October, 2022. The excursion is designed to support the students' learning in History, Geography and PDHPE.

The 3-day itinerary is still being confirmed with our tour provider however it is hoped students will:

- visit Echo Point and view the Three Sisters
- ride the Scenic Railway and cableway and enjoy a self-guided walk along the Rainforest Boardwalk before enjoying a ride on the Skyway.
- drive around Mt Panorama Raceway
- participate in a Hill End village tour and Treasure Hunt
- Bald Hill Underground Mine tour
- Bathurst Goldfields tour with panning for gold at Tambaroora Creek
- tour the Hartley Historic Site including a mock legal trial in the Courthouse.

The exact cost of the excursion will depend upon the number of students attending. We anticipate the cost for the excursion will be approximately \$420 and is inclusive of transport, food, accommodation, activities and guided tours. A finalised excursion package including what to bring, itinerary, accommodation details etc. will be provided early next term and you will also be asked to complete a permission note, update medical information and dietary requirements, once the expression of interest closes and final excursion numbers have been determined.

In order to secure your child's place on the excursion (numbers are due to our accommodation by the end of Term 1) please complete the EOI over the page and pay the \$80.00 due Friday 8 April, 2022 (last day of Term One). Please note the <u>deposit is non-refundable</u> except in exceptional circumstances approved by the principal. If the excursion was cancelled as a result of Covid, all families will be refunded.

We would sincerely love to see as many students participating in the excursion as possible. If the cost of the excursion is a barrier, student assistance subsidies are available for eligible families. If your child will need student assistance, please contact the office to discuss how you can apply for this support.

If you have any questions or concerns about the excursion or wish to discuss financial assistance to allow your children to attend, please feel free to contact us through the school office.

We are looking forward to facilitating an interesting, fun and educational excursion later this year.
