Dear Parents and Carers,

Within the Personal Development, Health and Physical Education (PDHPE) syllabus, students in Stage 2 and Stage 3 learn about physical changes to their bodies, respectful relationships and they develop strategies for coping with changes in their lives. To support this development, we'd like to offer parents, carers and students in Stage 2 (Years 3 and 4) and all students in Stage 3 (Year 5 and 6) the opportunity to participate in a program offered by 'Interrelate'. This program includes both a Family Evening Program and lessons delivered during the school day and provides the opportunity to facilitate communication between parents and their children around the topics of preparing for puberty.
