SCHOOL SWIMMING SCHEME 2022 (Years 2-6 only)

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Your son/daughter/ward has the opportunity to attend the School Swimming Scheme at Swansea Swim Centre.

Venue: Swansea Swim Centre (pool), Belmont Street, Swansea
Cost: \$35 for bus **to the pool** and pool entry for the 10 days
Dates: Monday 21st November – Friday 2nd December 2022
Time: Bus to the pool, with parents picking up students from the pool at 2:50pm
Supervision: Classroom teachers
Dress: Students should wear their school uniform to school. Students to change at the pool.

Other equipment:

Students will need to bring a swim bag/plastic bag with their swimmers, towel, 50+ water resistant sunscreen, swim shirt/rashie and water bottle. Warm clothes to get changed into after swimming on cold days are recommended. Asthmatics should bring their own puffer. ***Students who do not have a swim shirt/rashie will be loaned one by the school. Students are not able to participate unless they are wearing a swim shirt or rashie.***

Please ensure that all items, including the swim bag, are clearly labelled with the students name so that we can easily identify lost property.

OTHER INFORMATION:

If your child has a 'Pool Pass' or a 'Fitness Passport' could you please provide a copy to the school. The office staff are able to photocopy your card. Even though the school grant is allowing us to subsidise the cost of the scheme, any passes will still be of benefit to the school. Please attach a photocopy to the permission note or see office staff to have it photocopied and attached. Students will be travelling to the pool every day by bus with parents/carers asked to collect their children from the pool. This is to minimise the cost. Please indicate on the permission form over the arrangements for your child/ren.

For parents/carers with students in both Years K-2 and 3-6, please note that there will be teachers remaining back at school to supervise children not attending the swimming scheme. This will allow parents/carers to pick up children from the pool before coming back to pick other up from school.

Numbers for the school swim scheme are strictly limited to 60 students due to travel arrangements and the number of swim instructors available. Students whose note is not to the school by **Friday 4th November** will not be attending the School Swimming Scheme. Students not attending will be staying at school where a teacher will supervise them until 2:55pm.

Please complete and sign the attached permission note and pay \$35 fee by **Friday 4th November 2022**.

Note: If an accident occurs at school or on an excursion which is not caused by negligence of the Department of Education, then parents/guardians are required to have their own insurance.
