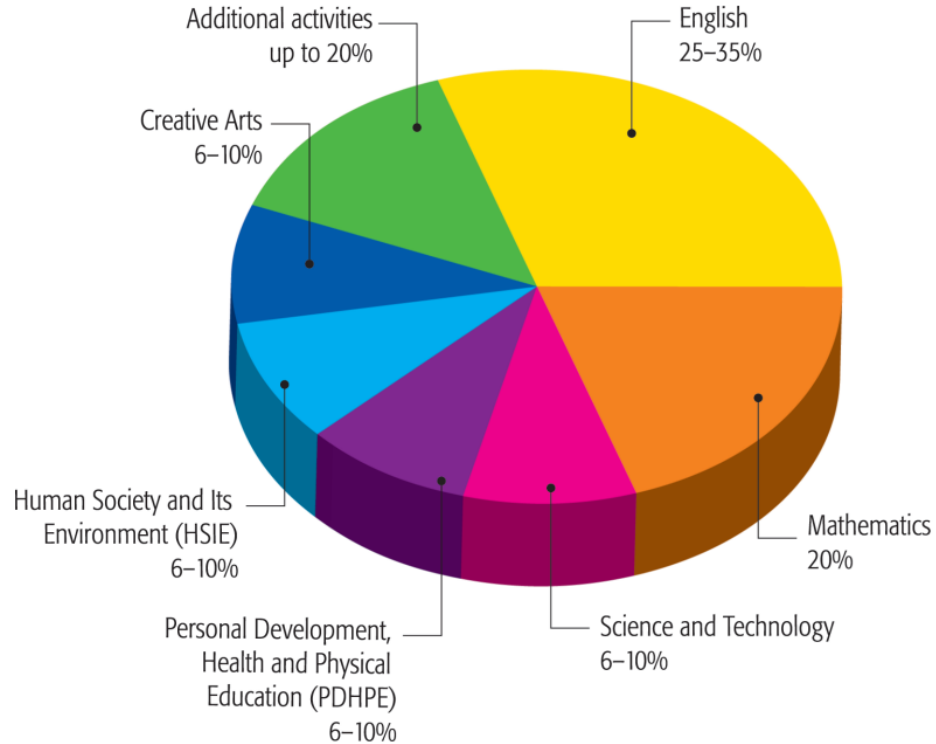

- Year 1 2022 teaching team was been involved in the implementation of new English and Mathematics K-2 syllabuses last year as a 'Self select' school.
- All staff currently have access to the new **English** and **Mathematics** K-2 syllabuses and teaching units now and have been preparing and planning for implementation this week.
- In my role as APC&I I will be supporting staff in classrooms with demonstration lessons, team teaching and lesson observations to assist with the implementation of the new Curriculum and pedagogies, such as gradual release model, explicit teaching & formative assessment.

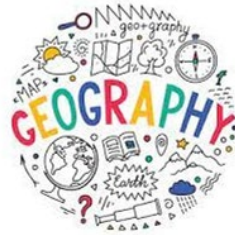
