## **Important information:**

- This information relates to registration for the NSW Primary All-Schools Girls 12 Years & Under Australian Football Selection Trials for the 2020 School Sport Australia Girls Australian Football Championships.
- Girls are to register and attend the regional trial closest in proximity to the school in which they are enrolled.
- **Girls can only attend one regional trial.**
- Girls successful in being selected at their regional trial, will be required to attend a final selection trial on Friday 22 May 2020 at a venue to be confirmed in the Sydney metro area.
- Any student participating in the selection trials must be available to attend the School Sport Australia Girls 12 Years and Under Australian Football Championship in Adelaide, South Australia from Saturday 1 to Saturday 8 August inclusive.
- Students should wear appropriate attire and football boots for playing Australian Football. Mouthguards are compulsory. Please ensure your child has sufficient food and drink (minimum two water bottles) for the day, particularly in the event of hot weather.
- All students must be registered via the online registration form with all the requested information provided and the following **consent form** completed and uploaded.
- Only students participating in the selection trials will be considered for the state team and students must participate at the trial to be considered for selection.
- No special consideration will be given to students who cannot attend due to clashes with other sporting or personal commitments.
- Registrations close at 5:00pm Friday 13 March 2020. Late applications will not be considered.
- There is a \$10.00 per student entry fee to be paid as part of the registration process.

**Age eligibility:**

These trials are **only for Primary School Girls 12 years and under**. Girls can be 12, however must not be turning 13 in 2020. Girls enrolled in Secondary Schools and turning 12 in 2020 are ineligible to trial.

Participants must be in at least their tenth year (turning ten during the year of competition) in order to compete at a School Sport Australia Championship as per School Sport Australia policy.

**There are no events at the SSA 12 Years & Under Championships for competitors under ten or turning thirteen.**

**Registration:**
