## Welcome to Year 6 – 2020

Dear Parents / Carers,

We would like to welcome the students and families to Year 6 for 2020. We are currently planning a wonderful year for your child and we are especially looking forward to our Canberra Excursion in Term 1. We have high expectations for these children as the future leaders of our school, and know that they will do a fabulous job of living out our school motto Word and Deed.

Next year, we welcome Miss Jenny Khazen to our school and to our Year 6 teaching team with Ms Desira. We are very excited to get to know your children, what inspires them, what interests them and what makes them the people they are. We are looking forward to embarking on our journey of learning together with you and your children in 2020.

All students will have access to class stationery and workbooks as covered by the school Resource Fee. In addition, it is necessary for children to manage their own set of essential personal stationery items for their daily use (see list below).

In preparation for Year 6, we would like all children to have the following items. Please keep in mind that these things do not need to be new - pencils etc from this year would be great to use again for next year. Please ensure that any personal items are clearly LABELLED with your child's name. This encourages personal responsibility and ensures that lost items can be recovered and returned easily.

- A small pencil case with a lead pencil, blue, red and black pen, highlighter, rubber, scissors and glue stick.
- Another pencil case for other stationary like coloured pencils or crayons, textas, sharpener.
- Clear plastic 30cm ruler.
- 2 glue sticks
- 2019 student diary (inexpensive one from Kmart or any variety shop)
- Earphones (inexpensive variety to be used with iPads and laptops)
- Library bag (available from Uniform Shop \$10)
- 2 boxes of tissues (as a part of a class supply)
- 2 packs of baby wipes (as a part of a class supply)
- Paint shirt (students can bring their previous paint shirt from 2019)

In the first few weeks of 2020, we will be sending home exercise books for covering. Could you please cover these in clear contact or plastic and label them with your child's name, class and the book name. (Learning Journal, English, Maths and Scrapbook). Students are encouraged to decorate and individualise their front covers.

As you are aware, the Seesaw app is the way that teachers, students and parents communicate with each other about grade based information and student learning. This year, we have subscribed to Seesaw for Schools so the end of year processes for your child's Seesaw account will look different. You will no longer need to archive your child's account at the end of this year. Instead, you will be invited to your child's new SeeSaw account once this has been successfully set up. There will be more information about this as necessary. This is a really exciting upgrade that will allow you to keep a digital journey of your child's learning from Kindergarten to Year 6.

**Important dates for next year:**

**Wednesday 29 January – MAI testing day.** Please see accompanying letter to book a time for a Mathematics Assessment Interview for your child with their teacher. This one day has been set aside especially for this assessment. It is very important that an interview time is made for each child.

**Thursday 30 January – Years 1-6 return to school for normal classes**

These school holidays, we are encouraging all students to participate in the Executive Director's Summer Reading Challenge and read, read, read!
