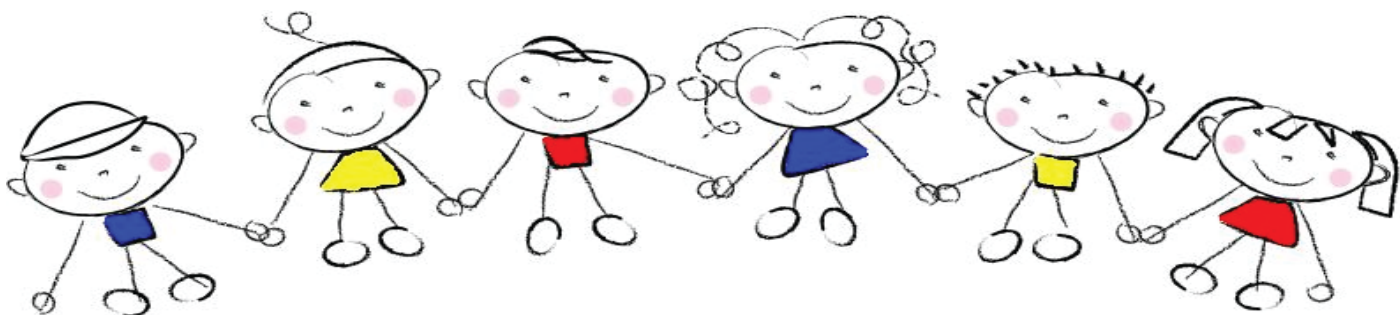


## St Joseph's OSHC Hindmarsh Vacation Care Itinerary July 6<sup>th</sup>- 17<sup>th</sup> 2020

Date	Activity
<b>Monday 6<sup>th</sup> Soccer Clinic</b>	Come and be a part of our interactive soccer clinic whilst we learn soccer skills run by our educator Nick with years of soccer coaching experience. We will be spending the day playing a variety of sports.
<b>Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> Sensory Play</b>	Come and explore your senses. Make your very own clear slime and customise it with your favourite colours. We will also have a variety of sensory activities for the children such as coloured rice, soap and bubbles, and much more!
<b>Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> Master Chefs</b>	Utilising our cooking skills as we build our own pizzas for lunch and choose your own toppings. The children will also have the opportunity to help make a hummingbird cake for snack. <b><u>Please note: Provide lunch to your child if they do not like pizza.</u></b>
<b>Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> Egyptian Knitting</b>	Take an imaginary flight to Egypt and learn how to make some cool Egyptian knitting. Our educator Magy will be leading the expedition to Egypt and she will lead an Egyptian knitting masterclass. You will be given the opportunity to knit something to donate to those in need or keep for yourself.
<b>Friday 10<sup>th</sup> Community Day</b>	Take the opportunity to give back to your community. Today the children will be making thank you cards for those who worked hard during this pandemic. All children will have the opportunity to write customised messages to our essential health professionals.

**Please note due to COVID-19 Federal Government Free Childcare Package means that the cost of childcare is free at moment but may change at any time according to the Government policy. There is some indication this will cease at the end of June 2020. If the childcare package ceases the cost will be \$55 a day per child for this Vacation. Please note, external activities will not be provided due to COVID-19 restrictions.**

Child Care Subsidy (CCS) is available eligible parents/caregivers if the Free Child Care Package ceases. To access CCS eligible parents/caregivers may need to complete an online form through my gov or phone the Family Assistance office (FAO) on 136150.

### **BOOKING AND CANCELLATION:**

If your family is not currently enrolled in St Joseph's OSHC Enrolment Forms must be completed. Families must fill in Vacation Care Booking Sheets and permission sheets and return by Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> July to confirm your booking.

**Staffing arrangements are dependent on your confirmed bookings. Cancellations to be 24 hours in advance or absent fee will be charged if applicable.**

### **LUNCHES**

Please ensure students have packed morning snacks and lunch. Afternoon snack will be provided daily and lunch when indicated on programme. We do advise children to bring Healthy Snacks and Lunches and a refillable drink bottle to Vacation Care. **DO NOT send food to Vacation Care that contains nuts.**

**EXCURSIONS – Not Applicable in this Vacation Care due to COVID-19 restrictions**

### **BEHAVIOUR**

It is important that Vacation Care provides a safe and fun environment for all, therefore staff will manage all forms of inappropriate behaviour in the most proactive manner possible. Inappropriate behaviour will be treated promptly. In some cases, parents may be contacted to come pick up their child immediately in order to provide a safe environment for all.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

All children **must** bring their hat each day, as per Sun Smart Policy. Hats are required if the UV levels are 3 or above. Staff will check UV ratings daily. Sunscreen is available at Vacation Care. During the summer months children must wear shirts or t-shirts. **Tank tops, singlet tops and thongs are not appropriate clothing.** Please make sure all hats and clothing are clearly labelled with your child's name.

**Mobile phones** are not allowed to be used by the children during the programme. If parents need to contact their child/ren please ring the OSHC mobile 0408 809 107.

Toys from home including electronic devices/games/equipment are not to be brought and used in Vacation Care unless specified in the programme.

### **MEDICATION/ILLNESS/ACCIDENTS**

All medication requirements must be notified to staff beforehand and a medical form completed and a copy of any Health Care Plans. Due to COVID-19 we have strict infectious disease policy, please keep your child home if they are unwell to minimise the risk of spread to other children and staff and contact OSHC. If your child has an accident or illness whilst at Vacation Care you will be contacted. **Please ensure your emergency contacts are correct.**
