Baptism Preparation Team

The Cathedral Parish of St. Joseph's Baptism Team plays an integral part in the formation of Parents and Godparents as they prepare to bring their child/ren to Jesus through the Sacrament of Baptism. Baptism is the first Sacrament of Initiation.

The Baptism Preparation process is a ministry that brings together parents in an environment of sharing and collaborating on the joys, privileges, and challenges of raising a Catholic family today. As a member of the Baptism Preparation Team it is a blessed opportunity to share faith and life experience in a unique way. It is also essential to reinforce that the parents are the first teachers of their children.

When seeking Baptism for children:

The Church asks that at least one of your child's parents is a Baptized Catholic and at least one godparent is a fully initiated Catholic. That is, over the age of 16, baptized and confirmed Catholic. Additional persons baptized in a recognized Christian faith are known as "Christian Witnesses" and are also eligible to assist the parents in this role.

If families need to seek further information regarding the expectations of the Catholic Church – please contact the Cathedral Parish of St Joseph 4927 6744.

Each sacrament follows a process, and this is explained to families as they prepare for Baptism: e.g. the symbols

- The assembled community at Baptism is a symbol of welcome and represents the community of Christ into which the baptized will be incorporated.
- The Sign of the Cross Parents and godparents trace the cross
- The Word of God

- Water is the central symbol of Baptism.
- The white garment with which the newly baptized is clothed symbolizes their new life in Christ.
- A baptismal candle is lit from the paschal candle and presented to the new member as a sign of the light of Christ.
- Oil is used twice in the ceremony.

Helping families to get ready for Baptism is more than just rehearing them for the day – Baptism is the start of a lifetime of exploring faith at home and with their new Church family.
