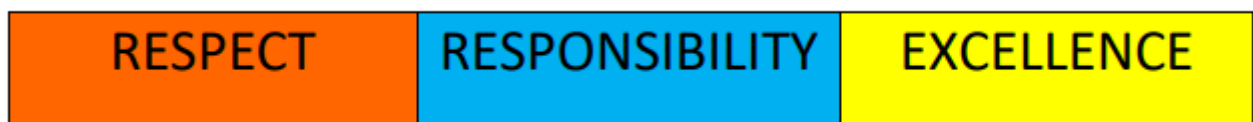


Some of our students exploring Augmented Reality possibilities with Mr McCarron.
