## **Dear Parents and Carers**

I am writing to inform you about the details for the Year 12 Reflection Day that will be held here at the college on Friday, 31 July 2020. We are very aware that the Year 12 cohort has missed a number of their final year events and we have listened to their concerns regarding this and are making every effort to ensure that we can celebrate this day with them in the last year of schooling.

The theme of the day is, "Let Your Light Shine." The activities on this day will allow them to reflect on their uniqueness and the responsibility that they have in using their God-given gifts and talents to be the best person they can be and to make the world a better place.

This is a compulsory school day so all students are expected to attend unless they are sick. Attendance at the Reflection Day will appear on the front cover of the Semester 2 report.

The structure of the day will follow the normal school hours.

Students may wear appropriate mufti or sports uniform on the day. Students will be participating in physical activities such as games outside or activities that require them to sit on the floor, therefore, appropriate clothing must be worn. No singlet tops, or midriff tops are allowed. Students must make sure that they wear closed-in shoes, no thongs or sandals are to be worn. This is a safety requirement.

Students will need to bring their drinks, morning tea and lunch for the day. We will be sharing a picnic lunch so students are encouraged to organise this within their group, with each person bringing their own lunch or bringing individually wrapped portions to share with their friends. It would be advisable to bring a picnic blanket, a hat and some sunscreen so that they can sit on the grass outside if the weather permits. Students are encouraged to minimise wrappings and waste from their picnics. The cost of the Reflection Day has been included with the school fees for this term.
