

STAGE 3, WEEK 8 TERM 2

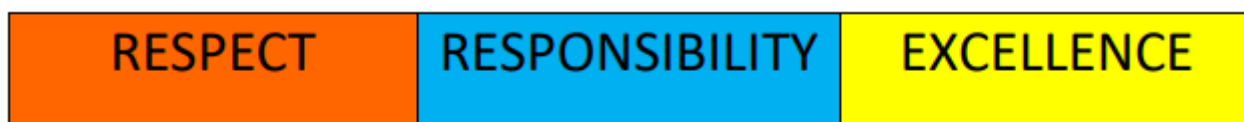
