This year there are many exciting events and learning to look forward to including:

- Another pencil case for other stationary like coloured pencils or crayons, textas, sharpener
- Clear plastic 30cm ruler
- Glue stick x2
- Earphones (inexpensive variety to be used with iPads and laptops)
- Library bag or Polly Wally (Available from Uniform Shop \$10)
- 2 boxes of tissues (As a part of a class supply)
- 2 pack of baby wipes (As a part of a class supply)
