PRIEST'S REFLECTION

Today is the second Sunday of Easter and is also known as the Divine Mercy Sunday. In today's gospel reading Jesus visited his disciples to convince them that He is risen, and he said to them– As the Father sent me, so am I am sending you. After saying this he breathed on them and said receive the Holy spirit for those sins you forgive, they are forgiven; for those whose sins you retain, they are retained. Jesus through this empowered them to forgive sin and by extension instituted the sacrament of reconciliation.

Today, the sacrament of reconciliation or penance is one of the seven sacraments of the church, through which the church calls us to amend our ways with God and with our neighbours, "those who approach the sacrament of penance obtain pardon from God's mercy for the offense committed against him, and are, at the same time, reconciled with the church which they have wounded by their sins and which by charity, by example, and by prayer labours for conversion" (CCC. 1422).

As we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday, let us know that God's mercy is so abundant and his love for us is great. Let us not be afraid to approach his throne of mercy, in any situation we find ourselves. Let us also be merciful and learn to forgive. Fr Matthias Ogwo
