Cost

Attendance and opening hours

Enrolled children attend kindergarten five days every fortnight during school term. This usually works out at two days one week, and three the following week.

Joeys attends Mondays, Tuesdays and alternate Wednesdays.

Possums attends Thursdays, Fridays and alternate Wednesdays.

Our hours are 8.30am – 2.30pm Monday to Friday.
