Child and Family Support Services

Our Child & Family Practitioners and Early Childhood Educators are able to work alongside families providing tailored one-on-one support depending on your needs.

Baby & Me

Connect with other parents and/or carers with children aged birth-12 months. Topics include growth and development, self-care, attachment and bonding.

Connect 2 Kindy (2.5 - 4.5 years)

Children are supported to develop skills which will enable them to transition smoothly from home into an approved Kindergarten program. We offer play programs for eligible children and their families.

Play & Learn Together (0 to 5yrs)

This is a group for children and their families to interact with others in a play based learning environment. Opportunities are provided to encourage learning and development.

Toddler Play & Learn Together

Families with children aged 1 year to 2.5 years are welcome to come and play with their children within a play based learning environment which is supported by our friendly staff.

Pals Social Skills Program

The Pals Social Skills Program emphasises the importance of involving parents and other adults involved in the care of a child in order to promote the generalisation of skills.

Incredible Years Attentive Parent Program (2 - 6 years)

This Program promotes emotional regulation, social confidence, problem solving and school readiness

Kindergarten (Beaudesert)

Offering an approved Kindergarten program and high quality education and care for children from the age of 3 years. The Kindergarten is attached to the Beaudesert Early Years Centre offering support from a range of health and community professionals working collaboratively to give children the best possible start in life.

Circle of Security Parenting™ Program

This program assists parents/carers in identifying and responding to children's emotional needs. This program aims to support, enhance and strengthen your relationship with your child.

123 Magic & Emotion Coaching

Sometimes, the job of parenting is tough and parents don't know what to do next. This parenting program teaches strategies to promote positive behaviour in children and tools to manage difficult behaviour with children from 2 and 12 years. Parents will also learn how 'tuning in' to their children's emotional cues builds both relationships and resilience.

Child Health Service

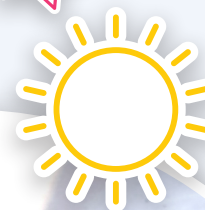


