

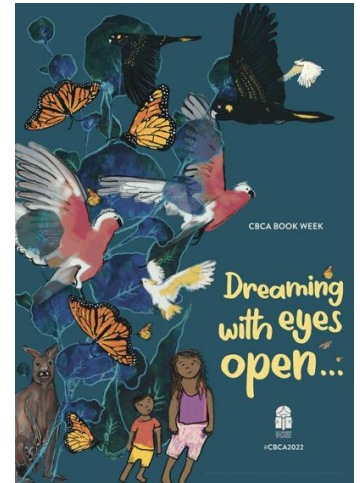


Junk Sculpture Competition

Plattsburg Public School is celebrating Book Week in Term 3 Week 3 this year. The theme of this year's Book Week is ***Dreaming With Eyes Open....*** We are asking for the students to dream of going on a holiday to another place in the world and create a sculpture of something they might see when they get there.

A Few Ideas:

Students might like to go on a holiday to space and create a sculpture of a new planet or creature they might see. They may like to go on a holiday to another country and create a sculpture of a place or thing they see, like an anaconda in the Amazon rainforest. Students could even dream of going on a holiday to a place from their favourite book, like Hogwarts from Harry Potter!



Students can use some spare time in the holidays to get started with their Junk Sculpture creation. Students are encouraged to collect and reuse household items, such as paper towel rolls, egg cartons, cereal boxes and bubble wrap, and turn them into a creation.

Your sculpture needs to be completed and brought to school on **Friday 29th July** (Term 3 Week 2). Students will be required to carry their sculpture into school on their own, without the assistance of a parent or carer. Sculptures are to be taken directly to the school library between 8:30am - 8:50am on this day. Please note - sculptures **will not be accepted before this date.** Please do not place your child's name on the sculpture to ensure judging is objective.

Prizes:

There will be prizes for the best infants (Years K-2) and primary (Years 3-6) sculptures. Winners will be announced during our Education/Book Week celebrations the following week (Term 3 Week 3).
