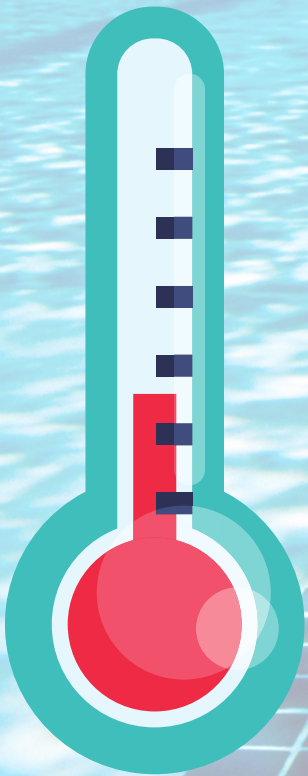
# PHPA FUNDING

All your donations are used to enhance the facilities at Pittwater House. The PHPA Committee works closely with the Business Manager and Facilities team to allocate funds to projects that will have the biggest impact for the benefit of all students.

The \$50,000 raised from the 2018 Christmas Markets has been allocated to the re-lining of the School pool. This mammoth undertaking is scheduled for Winter 2020 and quoted at \$180,000. The PHPA committee has agreed to keep adding our 2019/20 initiatives to this amount and with the MDL 2019 funds, this leaves us with a goal of \$110,000 to raise over the next 18 months. We'll keep you updated by way of a donation barometer on the PHPA Community noticeboard (a copy of which will also be on Skoolbag!). We are already 40% of the way there!

In order to make the pool the jewel in the crown of Pittwater House, a number of other works such as a new sophisticated heating system is required.

The PHPA committee will fund this endeavour from monies that were previously earmarked for projects that have now been incorporated in the Master Plan. The great news is that work on this can start this winter.

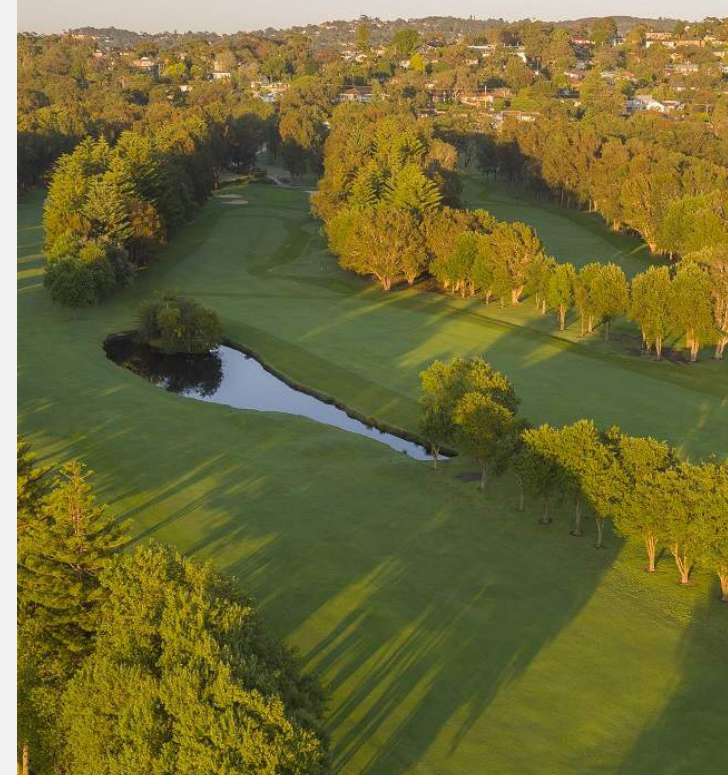

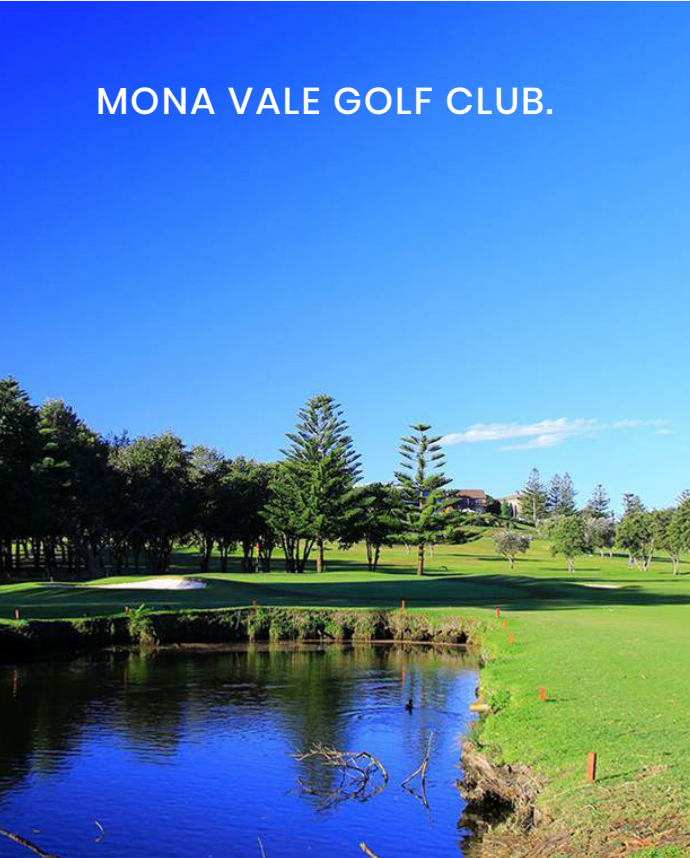

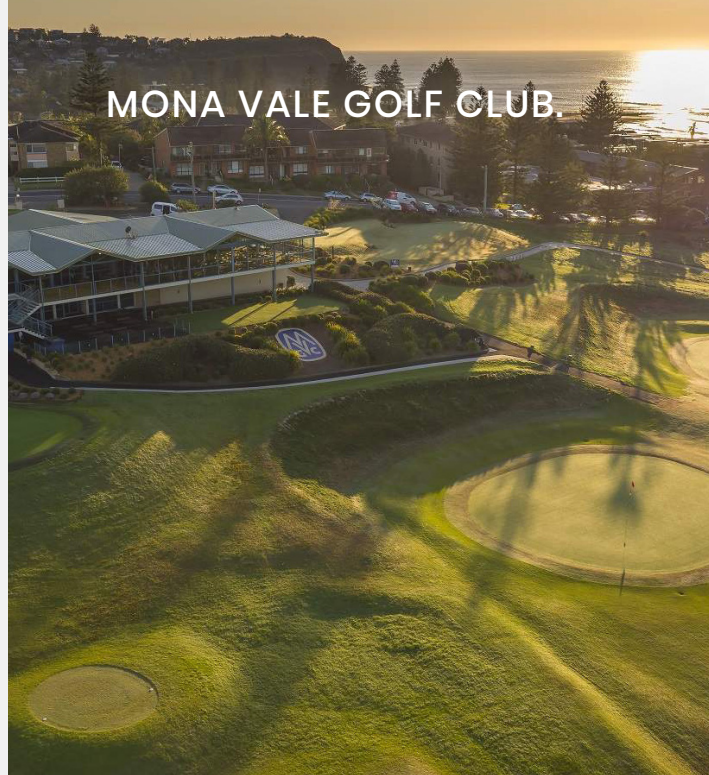
