Discord	Discord is a free voice, video, and text chat app designed to help gamers talk to each other in real time.  Users can join a chat or discussion channel they've been invited to or they can create private servers and invite their friends to play and discuss games by voice, text, or video.  Unlike other popular social media platforms, people use Discord to build private, invite-only groups where users have the option of opting-in to conversations. Facebook	Facebook is a social networking site that allows members to connect and share with the people, places and things that they care about.	Facebook is available to people over the age of 13. Minecraft & Minecraft PE	Minecraft is a construction game where players build block structures to protect against nocturnal monsters.	People of all ages can play Minecraft. However, children under the age of 13 are unable to create a Mojang account without their parents permission. Snapchat	Snapchat is a mobile application that allows users to capture pictures and videos and send them as messages to other Snapchat users. Every Snapchat message has a viewing time limit ranging from 1 to 10 seconds, as selected by the sender. The timer starts when the recipient views the message. When the time limit is reached, the message is deleted and can no longer be viewed using Snapchat.	Snapchat is intended for people who are at least 13 years old. Persons under the age of 13 are prohibited from creating Snapchat accounts. For certain features or functionality offered, users must be at least 18 years old. Facebook Messenger	Messenger allows members of Facebook to connect and share with the people, places and things that they care about through message texts, voice and video calls, photos and videos.  'Secret Conversations' in Messenger are encrypted end-to-end messages, meaning no one (including Facebook), apart from the person you are messaging, can see these messages.	Messenger is available to people over the age of 13 who have a Facebook account. Facebook will not create an account for a person who lists their age as under 13.  By creating an account, you agree to comply with Facebook's Statement of Rights and Responsibilities. For a succinct explanation of what can and cannot be posted to Facebook, check out the Community Standards page.  Only you and the people you're messaging can view the contents and history of your conversation.  Each of your conversations is separate. Even if some of the same people are in more than one conversation, Facebook doesn't combine those conversations into one thread. For example, if you have an ongoing conversation with just Jane, and then Jane is included in a different conversation among a larger group of friends, the original thread will stay separate from the group conversation.  A couple of things to keep in mind:  Conversations can be forwarded, much like traditional email  New friends can be added to group conversations, which allows them to see all previous messages in the conversation.	http://www.messenger.com/features
Fortnite Battle Royale	Fortnite Battle Royale is a popular, free version of the original Fortnite game. It is a 'battle royale'-style third person shooter game in which up to 100 players compete online through player vs player (PVP) combat to be the last person standing. In the game, players are dropped onto an island alone, or in a team of up to four players; players can choose the members of their team or be assigned random teammates. The object is to then explore the island, collecting weapons, building fortifications and engaging in combat with other players. Each game lasts approximately 20 minutes, with action intensifying as the eye of a deadly storm shrinks over the island, forcing players into an increasingly smaller playing area.  Fortnite Battle Royale is now available as an app on iOS devices and will soon be available on Android devices. It's also available on macOS and Windows, as well as PlayStation 4 and Xbox One.	Fortnite is not recommended for children under 12 years of age, as prescribed by PEGI, but you do not need to provide your age to be able to play online.  It should be noted however, that these ratings do not take into account the actual content of the game. Share multiple photos and videos to your story. Photos or videos on your story disappear after 24 hours and won't appear on your profile grid or in your feed.  Broadcast live to your followers in real-time only.  Send disappearing photos and videos, text messages and posts from your feed to groups and friends with Instagram Direct.  Watch stories and live videos from the people you follow in a bar at the top of your feed.  Discover stories, photos and videos you might like and follow new accounts on the Explore tab.
