# **Competition Terms & Conditions**

### NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN

The Executive Director's Summer Reading Challenge is sponsored by the Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta ('Sponsor'). This competition is governed by these official rules ('Official Rules'). By participating in the competition, each entrant agrees to abide by these Official Rules, including all eligibility requirements, and understands that the results of the contest, as determined by Sponsor and its agents, are final in all respects. ### **ELIGIBILITY**

The Competition is open to students in Catholic Systemic Schools in the Diocese of Parramatta.

# **COMPETITION PERIOD**

The Competition begins at 9:00am 2 December 2019 and ends at 5:00pm 2 February 2019. ("Competition Period"). All entries (submissions) must be received on or before the time stated during that submission period. Sponsor reserves the right to extend or shorten the contest at their sole discretion.

# **HOW TO ENTER**

Read at least one age appropriate book, e-book, animated novel, comic, play or piece of poetry and enter the Competition through <a href="https://www.parra.catholic.edu.au/News-and-Events/Whats-On/EDSRC">https://www.parra.catholic.edu.au/News-and-Events/Whats-On/EDSRC</a>. Entrants must fill out all required fields on the entry form as well as telling us in 50 words or less why you loved the book, e-book, animated novel, comic, play or piece of poetry. After submitting the required information on the entry form, the entrant will receive one (1) entry into the drawing. The more materials read, the more chances of entering the competition. You can enter as many times as you like BUT you must describe why you liked a different book, e-book, animated novel, comic, play or piece of poetry each entry.

# **WINNER SELECTION**

All eligible entries received during the Submission Period will be gathered into a database at the end of the Submission Period. Two (2) winning entries will be drawn from the submissions for the Google Chromebook prize – one (1) from the Primary entries and one (1) from the Secondary entries. Thirty (30) winning entries will be drawn from the submissions for a \$30 gift voucher.

The winners will be announced on or after 24 February 2020. Announcement and instructions for prize will be sent to the e-mail address supplied on the potential prize winner's entry form as well as



identified on the Sponsors Facebook page www.facebook.com/CatholicEdParra. Each entrant is responsible for monitoring his/her account for prize notification and receipt or other communications related to this Competition. If a potential prize winner cannot be reached by Administrator (or Sponsor) within fifteen (15) days, using the contact information provided at the time of entry, or if the prize is returned as undeliverable, that potential prize winner shall forfeit the prize. If a potential winner fails to comply with these official rules, that potential winner will be disqualified. Prizes may not be awarded if an insufficient number of eligible entries are received.
