CRICKET

Mosman Shield Cricket Match

This traditional Cricket match between the two schools Mosman Prep and Pittwater House took part on Monday November 25 at Mosman Prep's cricket grounds in Terrey Hills. We won the toss and elected to bowl first in the 25 overs a side Trophy Match. For the first time in our School's history we had a Junior College girl, Arabella, as a member of our Junior School 1st X1. Arabella represented the CIS Junior Schools Representative team in 2019 also the first girl from our School to do so; so we threw her the new ball to open the bowling for our team.

We soon had Mosman in early trouble in the second over when Arlo bowling his leg spin had their opening bat caught by Arabella, a sharp catch in the covers, when the score was only 8 runs, she took two great catches during their innings. We then saw a wonderful piece of work from our wicket keeper and captain Max who pulled off a sharp leg side stumping of their number 3 batsman from one of our fast bowlers left hander Adam. Adam then took another wicket two balls later in the same over to have Mosman looking shaky at 3 wickets for 43 runs after only six overs.

Arlo then pulled off a great piece of fielding in the covers to run out their number four batsman for only two runs to have them reeling at 4 wickets down for 59 runs off ten overs. Harry then tightened the screws when he came on to bowl his leg spin, he removed their top opening bat for 31 runs when Roy held onto a great catch at mid-wicket. Roy then came onto bowl his medium pace and he had an immediate effect on their innings. He took 3 quick wickets in three overs to have Mosman in shock at 8 down for 83 runs off only 17 overs. The end was near Arlo came back on and finished them off by taking their last two batsmen in his third over, he had one stumped by his brother Max and the other caught by Max. Talk about keeping it in the family. They were all out for 83 runs off only 19 overs a tremendous bowling and fielding effort from our entire team!

It was then our turn to bat. All we needed to do was show some composure with the bat to overhaul their modest total. We were one wicket down for 14 runs after 3 overs. Then two down for 14 with both of our openers back in the sheds. Max then came into bat and played a top innings giving Mosman no opportunities to dismiss him to top score for us with 38 runs only getting out in the 19th over with our score on 80 runs. Max with his brother Arlo who also batted with great control and an excellent technique to score 20 runs not out and hit the winning runs as a thunderstorm threatened to stop the game at any time. The brothers had shared in a match defining 50 run partnership together. Well played team; a great victory. It has been three years since we last held the shield. Man of the match for his wonderful batting and wicketkeeping was our Captain Max.
