

Swimming Carnival Information – Term 1, 2020

Dear parents and carers

The Balmain Public School Swimming Carnival will be held on **Tuesday**, **4 February 2020** at Drummoyne Aquatic Centre.

Please note: it is an OUTDOOR POOL – so although the grandstand has shade, **ALL students are required to wear a hat and sunscreen.** Teachers will have sunscreen available on the day, for student use. Students will be encouraged to apply sunscreen throughout the day.

Attendance is compulsory for ALL students in Years 3-6. Any students in Year 2, who are already 8, or turning 8 in 2020, are invited to participate. The carnival will proceed regardless of weather conditions and transport will be by bus. All students are required to be at school, no later than 8:50 am for class roll call.

The total cost of the activity is calculated by dividing the cost of pool hire and transport by the number of students who are expected to participate. Therefore, the cost for each student is the same whether or not they travel by bus. Spectators are most welcome on the day, however, will be required to pay entry into the pool (\$4.10). If you are available to assist on the day, it would be greatly appreciated. Ms Nancy Ferguson will be allocating roles on the day.

BRING: Hat, swimmers, towel, sunscreen, water, morning tea AND lunch (please do not rely on the aquatic centre canteen – minimal food will be available).

Please note: Ribbons will be awarded to students, who place 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th in the final, or 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th **overall** in the heats (where no final has taken place). **Place ribbons will not be distributed for individual heats.**

Swimming Carnival Medical Insurance Note – Term 1, 2020

Information about Medical Insurance should be read and signed to ensure your child is able to take part in this event.

In the event of injury, no personal injury insurance cover is provided by the NSW Department of Education and Communities for students in relation to school sporting activities, physical education lessons or any other school activity. Parents and caregivers are advised to assess the level and extent of their child's involvement in the sport program offered by the school, school sport zone, area and state school sport associations when deciding whether additional insurance cover is required.

Personal accident insurance cover is available through normal retail insurance outlets. Parents who have private ambulance cover also may want to check whether that cover extends to interstate travel and make additional arrangements as considered appropriate. The NSW Supplementary Sporting Injury Benefits Scheme, funded by the NSW Government, provides limited cover for serious injury resulting in the permanent loss of a prescribed faculty of the use of some prescribed part of the body.
